TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING on Tuesday, March 12th at 7p.m.

Our regular March Board Meeting will be held at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, March 13.

The Nessel Township Board of Supervisors is distributing this Newsletter to update you on agenda items for its Annual Meeting at 7:00pm on March 12, 2019 at the Nessel Town Hall.

The Board is planning on presenting for consideration a levy of \$490,782 for 2020 which is an increase of \$44,469 over the 2019 levy. A comprehensive study of past expenditures and future planning will be available at the Annual Meeting on March 12.

It is with heavy hearts that we report the passing of our fellow Board member Tom McKenzie. He worked tirelessly for close to twenty years to make Nessel Township and Rush Lake a better place to live. Some of his recent accomplishments include lobbying to get the cell tower located at Rush Point, he was instrumental in both Bayview and Belle Isle Dr paving projects. For years he served as the lead on the Nessel Township road committee and his legacy will live on every time people use the new picnic shelter that he worked to install at the Town Hall. He enjoyed being an active participant in many groups and clubs. We will miss his vast knowledge, huge commitment to our community and easy style. The Board wants to remind residents once again!!!

It is illegal to plow snow from your driveway onto township or county roads. Deputies may issue citations for such violations. If the Township has to clear the right-of-way, residents will be charged a fee of \$125 for the first offense and \$200 for repeat offenses. PLEASE, refrain from plowing snow into either the roadway or across the road into the “far ditch”. The Townships “right-of-way” extends 30 feet from the middle of the road on either side.
